- Johannes Hinterholzer** studied with Prof. Josef Mayr and Prof. Radovan Vlatkovic at the University "Mozarteum" in Salzburg. From 1997 to 2009 he was principal horn of the Mozarteum Orchestra Salzburg and since 2012 he is principal horn of the Camerata Salzburg. From 2000 to 2010 he led a horn class at the Anton Bruckner Private University in Linz and since fall 2008 he is professor for horn at the University of Music Munich.
