

MASTERCLASS CONDUCTING

LECTURER:



Prof. Guido Johannes Rumstadt, born in Heidelberg, studied conducting in Karlsruhe, Hamburg and Salzburg. His first positions as Kapellmeister took him to Staatstheater in Mainz, to Badisches Staatstheater in Karlsruhe, Staatstheater in Wiesbaden and Frankfurt Opera. From 1998 to 2004 he successfully served as General Music Director in Regensburg. Since 2007 Rumstadt has been the 1st Kapellmeister at the Nuremberg Opera House. Rumstadt has done guest appearances at numerous opera houses such as the New York City Opera, the English National Opera as well as the houses of Cologne, Düsseldorf, Nice, Oslo, Nantes and Minnesota. Since 2009 he has the professorship for orchestra and conducting at the Nuremberg University of Music.
