Prof. Henning Wiegräbe is professor of trombone at the University of Music and Performing Arts Stuttgart. Prior to joining HMDK Stuttgart in 2006, he supervised trombone classes at the University of Music Saarbrücken and the University of Music Basel. He conducts masterclasses worldwide, from Paris and Moscow to South Africa and China. Henning Wiegräbe's guiding principle in accompanying his students is to cultivate a comprehensive variety as a fundamental goal of their education. Graduates of his classes perform in top international orchestras, lead trombone classes at conservatories from Berlin to Leipzig to Beijing, collaborate with renowned period instrument ensembles and big bands, teach at music schools, and are prize winners in international competitions.
