### Prof. Andreas Schablas,

born in Mürzzuschlag, received his education at the Johannes Brahms Music School in his hometown, as well as at the Music Universities in Graz and Vienna. From 1999 to 2008, he was a member of the Mozarteum Orchestra Salzburg. Since 2008, he has been a member of the Bavarian State Orchestra, serving as the principal clarinetist since 2010.

In addition to performing the standard repertoire, he has a particular affinity for contemporary music. As a soloist, he has played the Austrian premiere of Jean Françaix's Clarinet Concerto and the world premiere of Friedrich Cerha's Clarinet Concerto, among others. Since October 2017, he has been leading a clarinet class at the University Mozarteum Salzburg.
