



VIOLIN INTENSIVE MASTER CLASS

INSTRUCTOR:

Prof. Ingolf Turban



At just 21 years old, he became the First Concertmaster of the Munich Philharmonic under Sergiu Celibidache. Following this, he embarked on a successful solo career on the international stage. In addition to performing the great violin classics, he introduces audiences to a repertoire that is sometimes unheard of. He has recorded over 40 CDs and has held a professorship in Munich since 2006. He is also active worldwide as a master class instructor.

WHEN:

March 10 – 12, 2024

The course begins on March 10, 2024 at 10:00 a.m.
Daily lessons from 10:00 a.m. to approximately 6:00 p.m

CONTENT:

This master class is limited to 5 participants and is particularly suitable for intensive preparation for auditions and competition. Key areas of focus include:

- Developing effective practice strategies
- Enhancing expression while maintaining physical relaxation
- Deepening knowledge of the repertoire
- Intensive consultations with the instructor

Each day includes two lessons, each lasting at least 45 mins. Participants have unrestricted practice time as they will be accommodated in single rooms. The instruction languages are German, English, and Japanese.

TARGET GROUP:

This course is designed for students who want to prepare intensively for auditions or competitions.

Maximum 5 participants with 90 minutes of instruction each day.
