



## MASTERCLASS DOUBLE BASS



## **LECTURERS:**

**Prof. Dorin Marc** is a professor of double bass at the University of Music Nuremberg. He completed his double bass studies in his home country. Romania, at the University of Music Bucharest under the guidance of Professor Ion Cheptea. Dorin Marc has been awarded numerous prizes both in his home country and internationally. He has performed concerts throughout Europe and conducted numerous masterclasses. His students have been winners of international double bass competitions such as the ARD Music Competition in Munich, the International Instrumental Competition in Markneukirchen, the International Johann-Matthias-Sperger Competition. and the Leoš Janáček International Competition in Brno. Many of his students have secured solo positions in prestigious orchestras.

Prof. Dominik Wagner is a recipient of the Anne-Sophie-Mutter-Foundation scholarship and an ECHO Klassik Award winner, all achieved at a young age, just in his mid-20s. In 2022, he was honored with the Opus Klassik award as an emerging artist.

Furthermore, he has been recognized as a prize winner in almost all double bass competitions, including the Bradetich Foundation International Double Bass Solo Competition, the International Music Competition of the ARD, and the Eurovision Young Musicians Competition. Since 2023, he has been part of the Professional Studies Program at the Kronberg Academy.
