CONTENT:

In addition on working on the oboe repertoire, **Stefan Schilli** works on topics such as „stylistic peculiarities in the 18th century“, orchestral excerpts, reed making and specific oboe techniques like double tongue and circular breathing.

Susanne Schlusnus Susanne Schlusnus works with her concept PHYSIOBOE: Optimal playing technique should be in harmony with physiology, the natural and healthy functioning of the human body. The Physiology of oboe playing examines the effects of all influencing physical factors on playing-technique and sound quality to create an optimal body-oboe connection. Biomechanical analyses from functional anatomy (also used in sports) as well as body awareness and mental components help to recognize bad posture and unphysiological playing habits. After achieving an ideal playing position with a well-balanced amount of body tension, playing technique can be optimized in all areas. The goal is an effortless, reproducible playing experience – free and flexible!

The topics of breathing and sound system and articulation are also worked on together by both instructors, and in **Team-Teaching**, all aspects of the artistic-musical work and PHYSIOBOE are combined for a convincing performance.

This course is aimed at interested music students, advanced teenagers, prospective music students, and professional musicians who want to expand their oboe and interpretative capabilities.
