CONTENT:

It's the variety of grooves and rhythms that gives jazz its unique flavor. From the very beginning, Caribbean music has been an essential ingredient in the musical melting pot of New Orleans — so much so that people often say New Orleans is not the southernmost city in North America, but the northernmost city in South America.

Over time, many musical delicacies from Brazilian music were added to the jazz musicians'

menu. Soul, jazz, funk, and fusion later rounded out the mix.

In this workshop, we explore all these different styles of jazz through numerous hands-on examples and arrangements.

At the end of the workshop, participants will receive materials to help them continue

developing the various grooves on their own.

**TARGET GROUP:** The course is not limited to the classic jazz piano trio setting — it is open to all instruments!

A solid technical level is recommended, as we will not be addressing instrument-specific

issues during the course. Max. 15 participants
